

## **Visiting Campus**

In accordance with the *COVID-19 Go-Forward Guidelines for B.C.'s Post-Secondary Sector*, to ensure the health and safety of our community during COVID-19, the following policy has been enacted for all visitors.

## **Mandatory Guidelines**

All Visitors must follow the Metropolitan Community College's Safety Plan including, but not limited to:

- For visitors, make an appointment with the person they are coming to visit
- Fill out and sign the College's COVID-19 Daily Checklist ahead for self-check
- Wear masks either a CDC-approved, personal mask, or a disposable mask
- Complete COVID-19 Screening: check in at front office / reception for confirmation of COVID-19 Daily
  Checklist, and complete temperature check before proceeding to their destination on campus
- Practice Social Distancing including adhering to any taped distancing markers, signage and occupancy limits

## **Self-Monitoring**

Self-monitoring is required for the safety of the entire Metropolitan Community College. All visitors with any of the following attributes will not be permitted to come to campus:

- Have a fever within 24 hours of visiting campus.
- Tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 30 days.
- Direct contact with a patient confirmed to have COVID-19 or with someone who is under care for suspected exposure to COVID-19 within the last 14 days.
- Traveled internationally or to a region that has high COVID-19 exposure rates within the last 14 days.

## **Important Note**

These policies will be in effect starting October 9, 2020 but may change at any time.

Depending on prevalent conditions, the College may distinguish guidance among Visitors.
